THE BOROUGH OF STOCKERTOWN HELD A BUDGET MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2015, AT 7:30 PM AT BOROUGH HALL.

Attendance

The Meeting was called to order by Council President, Amy Richard, at 7:30 PM

- There were no council comments

Secretary / Treasurer Report

- Secretary/Treasurer, Anita Caughy, informed council that Tatamy Borough would like Stockertown to participate in a joint recycling endeavor to be held at a central location for residents to bring electronic equipment to be recycled. The Boroughs who participate will split the cost. Tentative date is April 16, 2016.
- **Motion** by Carl Zito, Seconded by Robin Davis to join Tatamy Borough in the Electronic Recycling Project. Motion carried unopposed.

- Amy Richard informed council that the public work's wish list for 2016 includes a 14" Stihl K-Saw at a cost of \$1,200.00; Saw Blade at \$280.00 and Weather Tech floor mats for the new dump truck at a cost of \$110.00.

- **Motion** by Joe Gosnell, Seconded by Carl Zito to accept the wage scenario discussed in Executive Session on Worksheet 2016-4 to take affect retroactively starting October 1, 2015. Motion carried unopposed.
- Robin Davis stated that residents have come to her in Weis' Market and complain to her that they would like Halloween to take place during the day. She advised them to come to the council meetings to express their views.
- Amy Richard informed council that the Borough is right on target with their spending. The budgeted amount in the general fund for 2015 was \$536,506.85. The amount spent to date is \$400,893.04. There is \$135,613.81 left in the budget to cover expenses until the end of the year.
- Rosemarie Wenzelberger asked whether there are any "Slow" signs on LeFevre Road. She stated that motorists are speeding down that road now that it has been repaired.

- **Motion** by Carl Zito, Seconded by Joe Gosnell to adjourn the budget meeting at 8:35 PM. Motion carried unopposed.
