

**STOCKERTOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF JUNE 5, 2017**

THE BOROUGH OF STOCKERTOWN HELD A COUNCIL MEETING ON MONDAY, JUNE 5, 2017, AT 7:30 PM AT BOROUGH HALL.

**Attendance**

- Council Members present were: Council President Amy Richard, Vice President, Kathleen Zdonowski, Robin Davis, Cindy Hower, Joe Gosnell, Rosemarie Wenzelberger and Carl Zito.
- Mayor Charlie Davis and Borough Secretary/Treasurer Anita Caughy were present.
- Attorney Steven Mills from Asteak Law Office, Chief John Soloe and OIC Eric Schwab were present.

**The Meeting was called to order by Council President, Amy Richard, at 7:30 PM**

**Pledge of Allegiance**

**Public Comment**

- There were no public comments

**Council Comment**

- Carl Zito informed Council that Louise D'Achille planted fresh flowers on the Veterans Memorial.

**Secretary / Treasurer Report**

- **Motion** by Joe Gosnell, Seconded by Carl Zito to approve the Council Meeting Minutes of May 25, 2017 as written. Motion carried unopposed.
- **Motion** by Kathleen Zdonowski, Seconded by Carl Zito to approve Accounts Payable for the General Fund and Sewer Fund through June 5, 2017. Motion carried unopposed.

**Mayor Report**

- Mayor Davis had nothing to report.

**Police**

- Chief John Soloe read out the Call for Service Report from May 1, 2017 to May 31, 2017. He stated that there were 4 Narcotics arrests plus 2 other criminal arrests; 3 Motor Vehicle Accidents along with 1 hit and run; 72 Traffic Summons; 40 Traffic Warnings along with miscellaneous calls for a total of 193 for the month of May.

- Chief Soloe stated that Northampton County Youth Field Day was held on Saturday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> at the ball field. The Foundation was celebrating their 25<sup>th</sup> year of the youth field day. Chief Soloe received all positive feedback from those in attendance. Stockertown Police donated t-shirts for the children who participated. Officer Schwab and Officer Sabbagh both assisted with the event. Chief Soloe stated that the Borough's Solicitor, Gary Asteak, also volunteered and was working with the kids. It was a very enjoyable event for all the children and their parents and Chief Soloe was very proud of his department. The Foundation once again donated \$500.00 to the Borough for the police support and maintenance help with this event.

## Zoning

- Amy Richard questioned John Soloe on how the Grease Ordinance was progressing. Mr. Soloe stated that he will follow up with Dave Shields who was reviewing the draft.

## Solicitor

- Attorney Steve Mills presented an Agreement between the Borough and Einfalt Recycling & Salvage in the amount of One (\$1.00) Dollar for the use of their truck weight scale during Einfalt's business hours. Amy Richard asked for a Motion to approve the Agreement.
- **Motion** by Joe Gosnell, Seconded by Carl Zito to approve the agreement between the Borough and Einfalt Recycling & Salvage for the use of their truck weight scale for the consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar. Motion carried unopposed.

## Agenda

- Estimates was obtained to remove and replace the current railings around Borough Hall and the Post Office with new steel railings. The estimates were as follows:

D.L. Keeney Contractors	\$7,159.92
Tri-Boro Fencing	\$9,046.00

Council discussed the companies and their proposals. They requested that the Borough Secretary obtain additional details from P.H. Barron Welding with regard to their quote before a decision can be made. Council agreed to have a Motion at this time and cap the authorized price for the railings at \$7,200.00.

- **Motion** by Joe Gosnell, Seconded by Carl Zito to approve the replacement of the Borough Hall and Post Office railings with a cap of \$7,200.00.
- Amy Richard informed Council that she is in the process of setting up a meeting with all parties involved with the Waste Water Treatment Plant in order to obtain a time frame for each step and what needs to be obtained to apply for a grant. She stated that she is committed to hook-up the Borough's system with Easton's plant and she needs further details on how to accomplish this outcome.
