

**STOCKERTOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL  
MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 14, 2015**

THE BOROUGH OF STOCKERTOWN HELD A COUNCIL MEETING ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2015, AT 7:30 PM AT BOROUGH HALL.

**Attendance**

**The Meeting was called to order by Council President, Amy Richard, at 7:30 PM**

**Pledge of Allegiance**

**Secretary / Treasurer Report**

- **Motion** by Joe Gosnell, Seconded by Carl Zito to approve the Council Meeting Minutes of September 2, 2015 as written. Motion carried unopposed.
- **Motion** by Carl Zito, Seconded by Robin Davis to approve Accounts Payable for the General Fund and Sewer Fund through September 14, 2015. Motion carried unopposed.

**Public Works**

- Two Guest Speakers, Stuart Cook and Richard Hummer, from Cook Contracting, LLC were present to explain their road paving proposal. Cook Contracting was the lowest of three bids for the road paving job. The procedure to be used is tar and chip paving which was explained to Council. They explained the benefits and cost savings for this procedure. Estimates were obtained for LeFevre Road and Commerce Way. After Mr. Cook and Mr. Hummer were finished they asked Council if they had any questions. Council discussed the matter and decided to have LeFevre Road repaired at this time. Amy Richard called for a Motion.
- **Motion** by Carl Zito, Seconded by Joe Gosnell to hire Cook Contracting, LLC to tar and chip LeFevre Road at a cost of \$18,400 to complete the project in one day.
- Tree removal on LeFevre road was discussed and will be decided at a later time.
- Alex Hennings, Director of Public Works gave details on the trail maintenance, maintaining the sewer plant and filling pot holes on Commerce Way.

- Mayor Davis had nothing to report.

**Police**

- Chief Soloe had nothing to report.

**Zoning**

- John Soloe stated that most of the high grass issues in the Borough have been resolved. He advised that there is still one property which has not complied.

- Solicitor Asteak stated that he spoke with the District Attorney’s office with regard to the reported stray bullets in the Borough. He advised that this matter is now in their hands.
