

**STOCKERTOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL
MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 24, 2014**

THE BOROUGH OF STOCKERTOWN HELD A BUDGET MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2014, AT 7:30 PM AT BOROUGH HALL.

Attendance

- Council Members present were: Council President Amy Richard, Vice President, Kathleen Zdonowski, Robin Davis, Joe Gosnell, Cindy Hower, Rosemarie Wenzelberger and Carl Zito.
- Mayor Charlie Davis and Borough Secretary/Treasurer, Anita Caughy were in attendance.

The Meeting was called to order by Council President, Amy Richard, at 7:30 PM

Pledge of Allegiance

Public Comment

- None.

Council Comment

- Amy Richard advised that the Gaming Grant was awarded to Stockertown. She stated that Chief Soloe did an excellent job with his presentation and that we were the first chosen for the grant. The new police car has been ordered and will take approximately 4 weeks to receive it. The cost of the new police car will be \$31,000 completely stocked. The Borough will only have to contribute \$1,500 for the purchase of the new car which is considerable less than expected.
- Amy Richard presented a list of the problems with the Borough's green truck. She also itemized the repair issues with other Borough equipment and vehicles. Mayor Davis explained the problems with the Borough's yellow truck. It was stated that \$1,900 was put into that truck during the last couple of months.
- Council discussed what to do with the Borough vehicles. What vehicles should be kept and which ones should possibly be sold.
- Purchasing a new truck for Public Works was discussed. Council all agreed to purchase a new truck.

Agenda

- The Profit & Loss Budget vs. Actual through the current date was reviewed by Council and for the most part everything was on target.
- Anita Caughy advised that the Borough was planning to change the phone system from Verizon to RCN which will reduce the phone bill to a ¼ of what Verizon is charging. Council agreed to change to RCN.
- Amy Richard asked Council if they would agree to put miscellaneous items on the Municipal Auction. They are considering selling the old generators, the truck, boat and other miscellaneous items.

- **Motion** by Carl Zito, Seconded by Kathleen Zdonowski to advertise equipment for sale at the Municipal Auction. Motion carried unopposed.

Adjournment

- **Motion** by Carl Zito seconded by Joe Gosnell, to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 PM. Motion carried unopposed.
