MEMORIAL HALL UPDATE

A second evaluation was done in June, by Alfero Contractors of Bethlehem. The purpose was to obtain a second non bias evaluation of the building inside and out for structural integrity, asbestos, ADA compliance, electrical, HVAC, plumbing, and code related compliances. This report revealed more areas of concern and the estimated repair/replace costs were upwards of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars. Because this building was a popular eatery and social gathering place in it's day, there is a degree of nostalgia present in the discussions of its possible future. In an effort to in-

clude and listen to all the Borough residents, whether they were involved directly or whether they know nothing of its past, we have scheduled a special meeting Thursday, July 23rd at 7:00 PM. We will review both evaluations and the dollar amounts associated with recommended improvements. We will entertain discussions for possible uses, funding and return on investment potential, as well as other options. Ultimately, without a benefactor, or a grant, the bulk of funding will be shouldered by you. Therefore it is in your best interest to attend.

- Thank you for you ongoing care of our Wastewater Treatment System.


YOUR INPUT IS IMPORTANT
