AN ORDINANCE

**AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF
STOCKERTOWN, CHAPTER 213, SUBDIVISION AND LAND
DEVELOPMENT, STREET DESIGN PROVIDING FOR CURBING
AND SIDEWALK ON BOTH SIDES OF ALL STREETS.**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Borough Council of the Borough of Stockertown, County of Northampton, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, pursuant to the provisions of Act 247 of 1968 (P.L. 805), Article VI, Section 601, as amended (53 P.S. 10601, et seq.) as follows:

SECTION 1: The Borough of Stockertown Code of Ordinances, Chapter 213, SUBDIVISION AND LAND DEVELOPMENT, Section 213-22, Street Design, Subsection I(1), Sidewalks and Curbs, is hereby amended to provide the following:

- (1) In subdivisions or land developments, curbing and sidewalk shall be provided on both sides of all streets. Sidewalks and curb shall be required adjacent to parking areas in multifamily developments.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby specifically repealed.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or portion or part of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of record or of competent jurisdiction, then, in that event, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain unaffected and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
